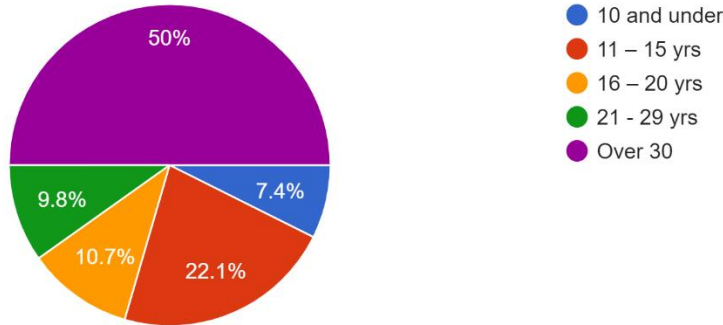

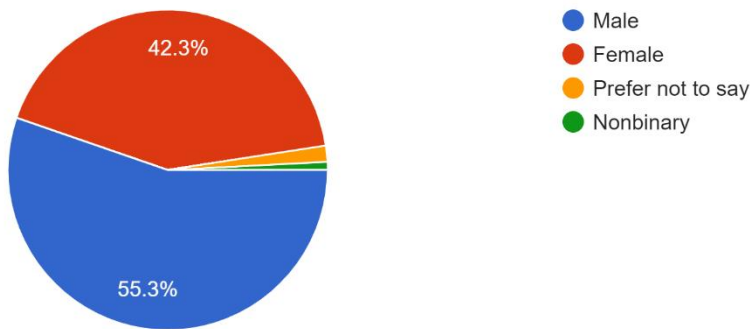
How old are you?

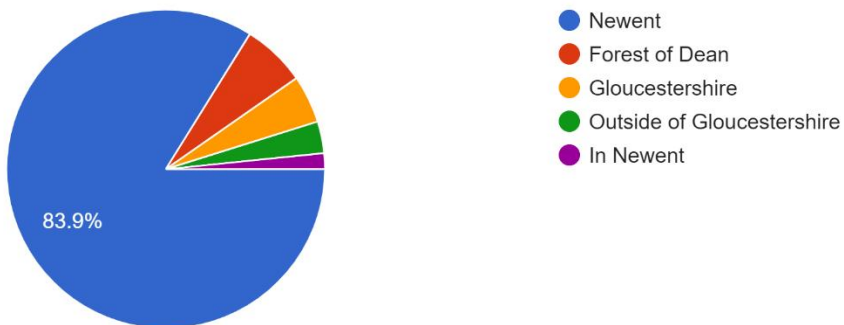
What is your gender?

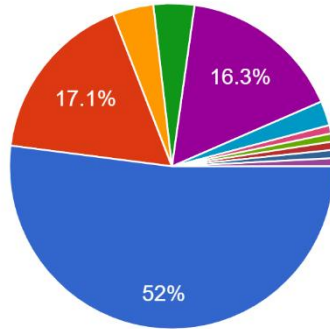
Do you live nearby?

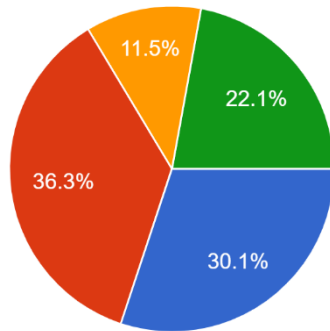

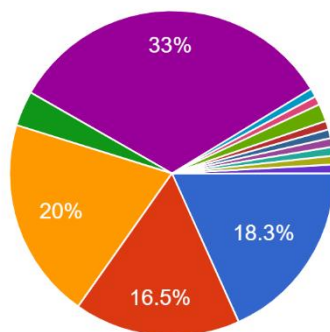

- I am not a skater so unsure if this has been covered but it would be great to see the site accessible for all ages and abilities, including wheelchair users and young children.



- Would be nice to include some small jumps, boxes to jump.
- BMX track like church down too
- Add a pump track and it would be perfect
- Add smaller dips for youngsters
- Make sure there's some smaller jumps and drop ins to start on
- I would suggest some smaller kicker boxes on the flat area to the right for novices to get used to before tackling the larger bowl. Make sure it can be well lit at night to ensure use in the winter and deter misuse
- Make it bigger and include a pump track
- Must be made for all levels of riders
- Will be great
- It would be nice to include additional benches for spectators and parents. I'd also like to see a larger area for beginners or young children to practice safely (without bigger or more experienced folks speeding through)
- Would be nice to see some kind of pump track or something more designed for early years
- Maybe some shade covering for summer months?
- The layout looks decent with some good lines, but I feel it is a bit simple. I'd propose (6) 1500mm qp becoming a volcano 900/1500 and leading back to a 1500mm transition/jersey next to (1)800mm qp? West edge between (1) and (7) could have mellow bank with curb top and some more ledges?
- Don't want this is our neighbourhood....
- Needs seats /benchs
- Looks good
- I'm not the skater, but it looks pretty good to me, and it's safer than the road !
- Add a pump track and this would be perfect
- The sooner its up and running the better, been a long time in the waiting.
